  - M. Clementi, F.J. Haydn, W. A. Mozart, L.V. Beethoven.
- One Virtuoso etude from: M. Moszkowski, F. Chopin, F. Liszt, S.Rachmaninov,
   A. Scriabin, C.Debussy, S.Prokofiev
- 4. One piece from participant's home country.
- 5. Pieces chosen from the repertoire of Vladimir Viardo: small pieces by Claude Debussy, D. Shostakovich, F.Schubert, F. Chopin, O. Messiaen,
  - S. Rachmaninov, S. Prokofiev, F. Liszt, N. Medtner.
